## **Checklist Before Leaving the Dock**

Diesel starts? Alternator charging?
Check transmission fluid, oil levels, diesel levels and strainer
Fill water tanks
Lash kayaks aboard
Lash dinghy on foredeck
Last minute check of weather
Honda generator stowed in bottom of the cockpit
Dock centering lines stretched across bow
Check GPS, set track if necessary
Turn windlass battery switch to ON
Check windlass for up/down as well as freewheel
Check that anchor is tied on for safety
Below – check for any loose objects, stow
For passage, make sure safety jack lines are in place and harnesses ready
Fill solar showers at dock
Make sure solar panels and wind generator are putting in amps
Jerry cans lashed to sideboard, dinghy fuel tank lashed to mast lean bars
Hatches & portholes closed
Turn instruments & autopilots on, check to make sure all are functional
Check lights, navigation and anchor lights
Winch handles out and in place

Get out binoculars, anything we'll need underway
Get paper charts out if necessary
Set up log if making a passage
Cockpit VHF mike in place, check for functioning
Put Monitor blade in place if using
Turn off everything at electrical panel to shut down AC
Remove shore power cord
Turn on electrical panel for DC, make sure fridge gets turned back on!
Get rid of any last minute trash.
Get lines ready for easiest exit
Covers off instruments
Main halyard hooked up
MackPack Unzipped
LEAVE!!! GOODBYE! ENJOY!!!  (note: there's always a "reason" not to leave pick your weather and do it!)
